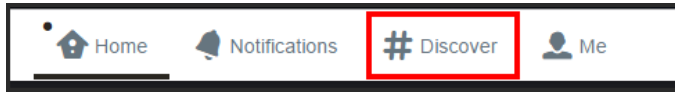


## Searching for a Hashtag

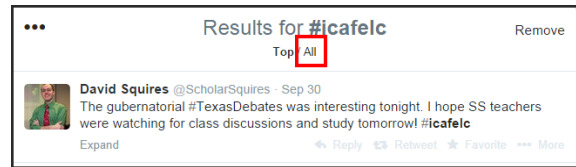


When following a Twitter chat you will want to do a search for the hashtag being used for the chat. Select the **Discover** option from the menu in the top left.



When the Discover page opens, search for the hashtag being used in the **search box** on the menu in the upper right. For example, search for “#icafelc”.

## Viewing the Chat Stream

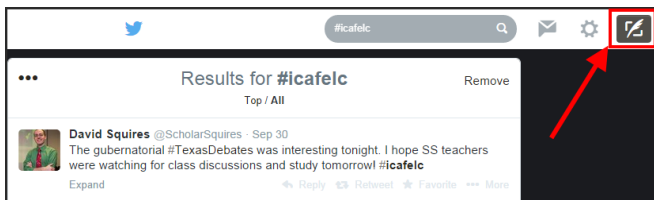


A list of tweets that include the hashtag you searched for will appear. By default it shows the Top tweets. For a chat you will want to show all tweets. Select **All** from the top middle.

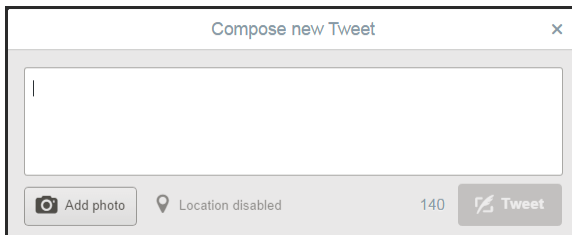


The page will not automatically refresh with new tweets. A prompt will appear at the top that more tweets are available. Click that prompt to reload the page.

## Posting a Tweet to the Chat



You can post a new tweet right from the Discover page so you can continue to monitor the stream. Click the **quill and paper icon** in the upper right of the screen.



A window will pop out. Type in your post and select **Tweet**. Be sure to include the hashtag that is being used for the chat so that it will appear in all the participant’s stream.

## Replying and Retweeting



To reply to someone’s tweet in the chat, click the **Reply** option located below the tweet. A window will open below the tweet with the other person’s twitter name there for you already. Once again include the hashtag of the chat in your reply.



If you find a tweet very insightful you can retweet it. Select the **Retweet** option below the tweet. A window will pop out. Once again select Retweet.
